1. Identification:

- Chemical Name: ISO-Butyl Alcohol

- CAS Number: 78-83-1

- Synonyms: 2-Methyl-1-propanol, Isobutanol

- Uses: Solvent, chemical intermediate, fuel additive

2. Hazard Identification:

- Hazard Class: Flammable Liquid (Category 3)

- Health Hazards: Causes skin and eye irritation, may cause drowsiness or dizziness, harmful if inhaled

- Precautionary Measures: Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames, and hot surfaces

3. Composition/Information on Ingredients:

- Chemical Formula: C4H10O

- Concentration: 100%

4. First-Aid Measures:

- Inhalation: Move to fresh air; seek medical attention if symptoms persist

- Skin Contact: Wash with soap and water

- Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes

- Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting; seek medical help

5. Fire-Fighting Measures:

- Extinguishing Media: Dry chemical, CO2, alcohol-resistant foam
- Hazards: Vapors may form explosive mixtures with air
- Protection: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)

- Personal Protection: Wear gloves, goggles, and protective clothing
- Spill Response: Absorb with inert material; ventilate area
